Meatloaf Memory

You'll need:

1 lb 93% ground beef1 lb ground chicken breast

1 lb ground pork
1 green pepper
1/2 sweet onion
3 cloves of garlic
3 tbsp dried parsley

3 tsp Jane's Crazy Mixed-up Salt

2 tsp ground pepper

3 eggs5 slices stale bread

Preheat oven to 350° F

Use food processor to chop bread into crumbs put in large mixing bowl, mince in processor, onion, green pepper and garlic, add to breadcrumbs. Start mixer on low or mix well by hand, add eggs, all the meat, Jane's, pepper and parsley mix till thickened. Form into loaf in 9x13 glass cake pan. Bake for 1 hr 30 min or until 180 degrees internal temp. Cover and let rest for 20 min. Slice and enjoy.

When I was in High School I worked at the Hitching Post in Sinking Spring, now it's a Wawa. For the last 35 years I have been trying to make a meatloaf that resembles theirs. It was my favorite meal there. This is my version of their meatloaf from 38 years ago. Hope you like it!
