WHAT IS IAQ AND HOW CAN COMFORT PRO HELP?

Poor IAQ is caused by lack of fresh outdoor air, poor ventilation of heating and air-conditioning systems, mold, excess moisture, high humidity, and indoor activities like smoking or remodeling. Health effects from indoor air pollutants may be experienced soon after exposure or, possibly, years later.

Immediate health effects include irritation of the eyes, nose and throat, headaches, dizziness, and fatigue. Many immediate effects feel like those from colds or other viral infections. Luckily, such effects are usually short-term and treatable. The likelihood of immediate reactions to indoor air pollutants depends on several factors including age and preexisting medical conditions. Long-term health effects may show up years after the exposure has occurred.

These conditions, which include some respiratory diseases, heart disease and cancer, can be severely debilitating or fatal.

> However, there are steps to take to ensure good air quality. The right mix of temperature, humidity

A Simple Roast Beef

You'll need:

1 - large chuck roast 32 oz. - beef stock (or) make stock from a beef base for soup

1 - large onion black pepper kosher salt nonstick pan roasting pan

Prepare:

Start by setting the oven to 275° F.

Cut roast into 3"x 3" pieces and season generously with salt and pepper.

Dice onion and place in roasting pan.

In a non-stick pan add a little olive oil, sear the pieces of beef on high heat till all sides are dark brown. It will smoke so turn the fan on or open a window. Place browned beef on top of onions in roasting pan, use some of the beef stock to remove all the brown bits from the pan and pour over the meat. Then pour the remaining beef stock over the meat. The stock must not cover the meat completely. About ¾ immersed.

Bake uncovered at 275° F for 5 hrs or until meat falls apart when pulled with a fork.

During the bake flip the pieces every 1 hr to brown on all sides. This is a very important step. You may have to add water depending on how much juice comes out of the meat.

When finished you may strain the juices and make a gravy by whisking in a butter and flour roux on medium heat or you can simply make beef sandwiches by pulling apart with a fork and then dip in au jus.
