- 1-32 oz can of tomato sauce
- 3-quarts unsalted chicken stock or fish stock
- 1 lb raw peeled and chopped shrimp
- 1 lb cooked chicken white or dark meat chopped
- 1 lb lump crab meat
- 1 lb smoked or andouille sausage sliced into half moons
- 6-green onions chopped fine
- 1-green pepper chopped fine
- 2-ribs of celery chopped fine
- 1-teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4-cup dried onions
- 1/2-cup dried parsley
- 2-bay leaves
- 3-tablespoons of File' (ground sassafras)
- Frank's Red Hot sauce
- · Cooked white rice

Roux

- 3/4-cup olive oil
- 1 1/4-cup flour

 $First \ make the \ roux. \ Combine the \ olive \ oil \ and \ flour \ in \ a \ non \ stick \ fry \ pan. \ Stir \ constantly \ on \ high \ heat \ till \ brown \ and \ smoking. \ Should \ smell \ nutty. \ Then \ set \ aside.$

In a 6 quart pot, bring stock to a boil, then add tomato sauce, green onions, celery, green pepper, garlic powder, dried parsley, bay leaves and dried onions. Slow boil for 5 min then add all meats except crab meat and simmer for 30 min till all veggies are completely cooked. Add file, crab meat, then bring to boil. Then add roux in small batches till thickened. Add Franks Red hot to taste.

Serve in bowl over rice and Frank's Red Hot on the side.

5 Tips for Keeping Your Pup Healthy this Winter

1. COZY COVERS: One factor that can be often overlooked in the winter time is where your dog sleeps at night. Making sure your pet has a warm place to sleep is equally as important as keeping them warm outside. Cold stone and concrete floors can pose a problem for pups, as they're more likely to retain colder temperatures. Make sure to give your pet a raised bed, or warm area to sleep in, preferably away from drafty areas. Keeping your dog's bed warm will allow older joints to rest comfortably and pups to stay healthy!

2. ANTIFREEZE IS ANTI-DOG: Surprisingly, the common winter product of antifreeze is said to taste sweet.
